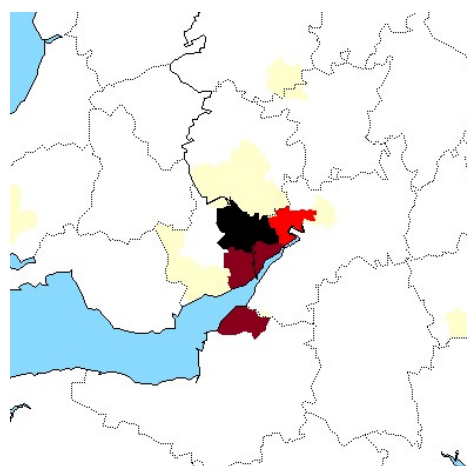


William and Ann's son Richard was born about 1686.¹⁰ In 1699, Richard 'late of Newland', in the Forest of Dean, Gloucestershire, was apprenticed to a joiner, William Lawrence, of London.¹¹ Richard married Mary Worgan at St. Nicholas', Bristol on the 5th of January 1716/7.¹² Two children were baptised at St. Andrew's, Awre with Blakeney, William on the 4th of October 1718 and Hannah on the 14th of September 1719.¹³ Richard was buried in Newland in 1754, 'of Coleford'.¹⁴

5x great grandfather **John** was baptised on the 13th of November 1690 in Newland.¹⁵ Alice was baptised at Newland on the 16th of August 1692.¹⁶ There were two other daughters, Ann and Elizabeth¹⁷ but nothing

more is known about these three girls. A fourth son, Thomas, is mentioned in the will of his father and brother but again nothing more is known.¹⁸ William senior was buried on the 5th of April 1698 in Newland, 'of Whitecleeve'.¹⁹ His will mentions houses in Whitecleeve and Coleford and an estate in Hillarsland.²⁰ William also refers to his 'master' Benedick Hall.²¹ In 1699, William's son's apprenticeship indentures refer to the late William as a 'Gent.'²²
